- I. Call to order by Eric Yokoyama at 11:10 A.M. Also in attendance: Lynn Matsubara, Stacey Kosaka, Jane Taguchi, and Eric Yokoyama.
- II. Minutes from July 17, 2010 were not available due to Lynne Tomita being absent.
- III. Treasurer's Report by Jane Taguchi – checkbook balance: \$5,515.63 as of December 12,, 2010. Jane presented a copy of the Treasurer's report to all that attended and a revised Profit & Loss statement. The Profit/Loss statement shows \$1,997.70 less the scholarship fund, equals to \$1,132.70. To contributions.)date, the scholarship fund has \$865.00 (2009 & 2010
- IV. Membership Report –
 - a. Stacey reported there are now 438 members.
- V. Tournament Committee
 - a. SFV Tournament: Eric reported that there are not many Senior teams entries (only half the center is filled.) Eric wants to keep the squads, because he feels that the future will have more people becoming seniors and eventually he will be bowling himself. .
 - b. SCNBA Singles: Squad is full. Bowlers will be bowling 2 games on the same pair and then change lanes. The Senior Singles has 47 participants and the house was full. A Roto-Grip ball will be raffled.

 - e. SCNBA Doubles tournament: On hold, looking at 2/13/11, possibly at Keystone or Carter Bowl.

 - g. Tournament of Champions: Will be held at Gardena Bowl on 6/26/11.

 - a. The Hall of Fame Certificates: tabled to next meeting.
 - b. Scholarship fund for 2010: There were no applications submitted. New applications will be distributed at the Singles tournament.
- VII. New Business:
 - a. Lynn Matsubara asked for ideas about the give-away in Sept. She would like to keep the cost per item to under \$1.00. The ideas mentioned were a coupon holder

- b. Stacey announced that she has started a league at Beverly Bowl on Monday nights. There is a decision to be made for a winter league. Stacey stated that Yuk wants to retire, and needs someone to take over. Stacey commented that we will need to discuss about excluding the subs from the qualifying percentage count for the league.
